The Health Communication and Informatics Research Branch in the Division of Cancer Control and Population Sciences (DCCPS), a component of the National Cancer Institute, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) and the Department of Health and Human Services, is seeking an innovative Health Scientist Administrator.

The individual selected for this position would serve as a Branch expert in behavioral science and research intervention strategies related to health communication; mass communication; translating traditional communication into the 21st century applications; and assist in shaping a behavioral research agenda for cancer communication and informatics in pursuit of the NCI 2015 goals.

Applicants will be evaluated on the extent to which their application shows possession of the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to:

- Establish and maintain liaison with government and private sector organizations involved in conducting relevant health communication research and intervention programs;
- Conduct theoretically grounded and well-designed health communication research studies;
- Evaluate the design, administration, and impact of health communication research projects;
- Plan the research design and implementation factors needed to conduct health communication research projects and develop health communication research project proposals;
- Effectively present information at seminars or professional meetings/ conferences on health communication research programs and applications;
- In collaboration with others, design a workshop or communication campaign;
- Publish health communication research reports and reviews;
- Develop effective avenues of dissemination such as journal articles, books, websites, newsletters, or other print materials;
- Create research reports, articles, chapters, papers, or other materials to disseminate to appropriate scientific channels;
- Evaluate research information for use in print materials or presentations; and,
- Conduct statistical analyses of nationally representative weighted data sets.
